Day 1 — Arrival & First Impressions

Morning — Departure from Teterboro Airport, New York

Private departure from Teterboro Airport aboard a Gulfstream G500, selected for its comfort, range, and refined cabin design. The journey begins with a seamless boarding experience, a quiet cabin atmosphere, and the privacy expected from a fully curated private aviation service.



Afternoon — Arrival in Medellín

At 1:15 p.m., arrival at Enrique Olaya Herrera Airport in Medellín. The descent over the Aburrá Valley reveals the city's green mountains and urban landscape. Upon landing, guests are welcomed with a direct and discreet arrival process.



Reception & Ground Transfer

A dedicated lifestyle concierge greets guests at the aircraft steps. A private luxury SUV is waiting nearby for the short transfer into Provenza. The welcome includes chilled towels lightly scented with orchid notes and chilled rosé. Approximate transfer time to Provenza: 15 minutes.



Check-In — El Cielo Hotel, Penthouse Suite

Private check-in at El Cielo Hotel. The penthouse suite is prepared before arrival with soft lighting, refined textures, and a floral composition inspired by native blooms such as pink guayacán and night jasmine. The check-in experience is calm, private, and personal.



5:30 p.m. — Rooftop Aperitif at ENVY

Private aperitif at ENVY Rooftop with panoramic views over Medellín. The setting includes curated music, floral accents, refined drinks, light seafood, and seasonal bites as the city moves into evening.



7:30 p.m. — Private Dinner at El Cielo Restaurant

Dinner at El Cielo Restaurant, featuring a thoughtful tasting menu inspired by Colombian ingredients, texture, memory, and sensory storytelling.



Final Ritual — Suspiro de Medellín

The evening closes with a delicate dessert inspired by the city's atmosphere. A Polaroid moment and a pressed flower with a handwritten note complete the first day.



Day 2 — Design, Memory & Living Identity

🕒 Reading Time: 3 minutes



Morning — Waking Up at El Cielo

The day begins in the private-access penthouse at El Cielo, with views of the Aburrá Valley and a quiet start designed around privacy and ease. Every detail is handled in advance so the day can unfold without interruption.



8:30 a.m. — Private Rooftop Breakfast

Ritual of Flowers & Coffee. Location: El Cielo Rooftop. A private breakfast overlooking Medellín's canopy, surrounded by a suspended floral installation with orchids, heliconias, and native foliage. Service is led by a dedicated host assigned exclusively to the table. The breakfast includes Colombian coffee, tropical fruit, fresh bread, and seasonal ingredients.



Johanna Ortiz Private Atelier

Private visit to the Johanna Ortiz atelier. The experience includes a floral welcome, access to textile archives, ancestral embroidery references, and a closer look at the silhouettes, prints, and materials that define the brand's identity. A private design conversation follows, introducing the concept of a personal commission: To Wear Your Aura.



Silvestre Collective

Private preview of selected pieces by Colombian designers. The conversation focuses on natural dyeing, textile memory, cultural expression, materials, process, and provenance. The experience is quiet, intentional, and editorial in tone.



Telúrico Textile Archive

Private access to a textile archive featuring historical fabrics, restored pieces, and materials preserved by local artists and artisans. The visit includes a chromatic consultation connecting color, texture, and personal expression. Guests may select references or materials to inform a future commission, accompanied by an artistic moodboard.



Lunch Within the Atelier

Edible Garden of Medellín. A vegetarian lunch inspired by native flora. Menu highlights: pink trout crudo with passion fruit and elderflower oil; wild mushroom quinotto with bijao leaf chips; guayacán blossom-infused water with kaffir lime; Jamaica flower sorbet with turmeric cotton and crystallized petals.



5:00 p.m. — Return to El Cielo

Floral Essence Recovery Ritual. In-room recovery ritual curated with jasmine and guava oils. The afternoon includes fresh fruit, herbal teas, and sparkling wine on the rooftop as a gentle transition into evening. A personalized soundtrack is prepared to match the mood and rhythm of the day.



8:00 p.m. — Color and Memory

Gastronomic Performance with Living Art. Location: private gallery in Provenza. A six-course dinner paired with live artwork created in real time by Colombian visual artists. The experience is curated by chef Álvaro Clavijo of El Chato in Bogotá. The artwork created during dinner is sealed, signed, and delivered to the suite before midnight.



Day 3 — Coffee Altitudes & Sunset Sky

🕒 Reading Time: 4 minutes



7:30 a.m. — Private Helicopter Departure from Medellín

Departure by Bell 429 helicopter from a private helipad in Medellín. The flight moves over the mountains, the Cauca River, and the changing landscape toward Colombia's Coffee Axis. Onboard light breakfast includes fresh pitahaya and guava slices, truffled pan de yuca, and cold brew coffee aged in rum barrels. A curated blend of ambient textures and slow Colombian boleros accompanies the flight.



9:00 a.m. — Arrival at a Private Hacienda in Calarcá

Arrival at a private hacienda surrounded by high-altitude coffee groves. Guests are welcomed with cool eucalyptus towels, coffee blossom mist, and a grounding ceremony led by the Experience Keeper, a local host connected to the land and its traditions.



10:00 a.m. — Coffee Tasting & Personalized Blend Workshop

Coffee workshop led by Carlos Imbachí. The experience includes comparative sensory analysis, guided palate mapping, and the creation of a personal signature blend. A Salento printmaker creates a custom label using botanical inks.



12:30 p.m. — Terruño Lunch Beneath the Coffee Trees

Lunch beneath the coffee canopy, created by chef Catalina Vélez and inspired by the surrounding landscape. Menu highlights include roasted arracacha root, river trout with tamarind, pearl corn arepas, and fermented pineapple with cacao nibs.



3:00 p.m. — Closing Ritual & Sensory Rest

Afternoon ritual beneath the Guayacán Tree of Memory. Includes a sound bath with crystal bowls and native flutes, massage with coffee essence, guava leaf, and andiroba oil, and optional rest in silk hammocks.



4:30 p.m. — Sunset Helicopter Return

The Golden Descent. Return to Medellín by helicopter during golden hour. Onboard service includes Perrier-Jouët Belle Époque Rosé, cardamom-roasted pistachios, and 80% Colombian dark chocolate with Guajira sea salt.



6:00 p.m. — Arrival in Medellín & Return to El Cielo

A Rolls-Royce Ghost awaits for the return to El Cielo Hotel. The ride is quiet and ceremonial, scented with palo santo and amber. Upon arrival, the suite is prepared with a warm bath, coffee-scented salts, candlelight, and soft lighting for rest. Original artworks by Federico Uribe and Flora Bursztyn add atmosphere to the room.



8:00 p.m. — The Art of Farewell

Final Dinner Ritual. Final dinner in El Cielo's private room, curated by chef Juan Manuel Barrientos. The evening includes intimate service, natural wines, botanical infusions, and a live artist creating a visual memory of the night. Each course is served with restraint and intention.



Day 4 — Departure & Farewell

🕒 Reading Time: 2 minutes



8:30 a.m. — Private In-Suite Breakfast

The Morning Linger. Private breakfast served in the suite. The morning begins with Colombian coffee, tropical fruit, and fresh-baked pastries in a calm and unhurried atmosphere. Menu includes carambola slices with edible flowers, mango coulis over homemade brioche, warm guava compote with cardamom, and cold-pressed coconut and turmeric juice. Soft acoustic jazz plays in the background.



10:00 a.m. — Discreet Check-Out & Transfer

The Lux Ritual Host manages departure. Luggage is handled, preferences are remembered, and each detail is coordinated with quiet precision. A private luxury SUV, scented with orange blossom and amber, waits at the hidden entrance. Transfer details: optimized route to the airport; discreet security coordination during transit; playlist featuring piano, cello, and soft echoes of Colombian boleros from Day 1.



11:00 a.m. — Enrique Olaya Herrera Airport

Arrival at the private hangar with fast-track assistance and VIP protocol. The Gulfstream G500 is ready for departure.



Onboard Amenities

Hand-embroidered linen napkin with a pressed guayacán petal; farewell note sealed with floral wax, including the playlist of the journey; scent capsule for in-flight aromatherapy with jasmine, palo santo, and Andean cedar.



Final Departure

The aircraft departs Medellín, carrying the memory of the journey through its landscapes, flavors, textures, and quiet rituals.
